Medicare Open Enrollment

November 15 — December 31



Plans change. You change. Shop and compare.

EACH YEAR, MEDICARE PLANS CAN CHANGE WHAT THEY COST AND COVER.

Every fall, **all people with Medicare** should review their current health and prescription drug coverage. Shop and compare to find the best plan for you.

IS YOUR PLAN STILL A GOOD PLAN FOR YOU?

Medicare can show you plans in your area that may

- ✓ Cost less
- ✓ Cover your drugs
- ✓ Let you go to the providers you want, like your doctor or pharmacy

You can also get

- ✓ An estimate of your out-of-pocket costs
- ✓ Quality and customer service ratings from current plan members

Decide which plan is good for you for next year. If you want to change plans, call the plan you want to join. Medicare can also help you enroll—online, in person, at an event in your community, or on the telephone.

FOUR WAYS TO GET THE HELP YOU NEED

1. **Call 1-800-MEDICARE (1-800-633-4227)**, and say “Agent.” Help is available 24 hours a day, including weekends. TTY users should call 1-877-486-2048.
2. **Visit www.medicare.gov**. If you want to look at Medicare health plans, select “Compare Health Plans and Medigap Policies in Your Area.” If you want to look at Medicare Prescription Drug Plans, select “Compare Medicare Prescription Drug Plans.”
3. **Look at your most recent “Medicare & You” handbook** to see a listing of plans in your area. You should also review any information you get from your plan, including the Annual Notice of Change letter.
4. **Get free personalized health insurance counseling** by calling your State Health Insurance Assistance Program (SHIP). To get the telephone number for the SHIP in your state, call 1-800-MEDICARE.



REMEMBER, MEDICARE PLANS CAN CHANGE EACH YEAR

IMPORTANT MEDICARE DATES

October—Review and Compare

Review: Your plan may change. Review any notices from your plan about changes for next year.

Compare: In mid-October, use Medicare’s tools to find the best plan for you.

November 15—Enrollment Begins

Decide: November 15 is the first day you can change your Medicare coverage for next year. This is the one chance each year most people with Medicare have to make a change to their health and prescription drug plans.

Enroll as soon as possible—the sooner the better—to avoid any issues at the pharmacy counter in January.

December 31—Enrollment Ends

In most cases, December 31 is the last day you can change your Medicare coverage for next year.

January 1—Coverage Begins

Your new coverage begins if you switched to a new plan. If you stay with the same plan, January 1 is the date that any changes to coverage, benefits, or costs for the new year will begin.

DO YOU NEED EXTRA HELP PAYING FOR MEDICARE PRESCRIPTION DRUG COVERAGE?

If you have limited income and resources, you may qualify for “extra help” to pay your prescription drug costs. Call Social Security at 1-800-772-1213. Ask for form SSA-1020 to find out if you qualify for extra help paying for prescription drugs. TTY users should call 1-800-325-0778.
